What is new?

- Old dumpsters will be replaced with 2 new dumpsters.
- 1 dumpster will be for non-recyclable garbage
- 1 dumpster will be for **corrugated cardboard only, (CARDBOARD MUST BE BROKEN DOWN)**

Don't fill the dumpster with air.



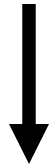

Combined Recycling

- All recycled items still need to be placed into the provided recycling cans/bins.
- All recycling cans/bins can now have **combined** recycled contents.
- Recycling cans/bins are located:
Upstairs in the kitchen
Comfort area downstairs

recyclables



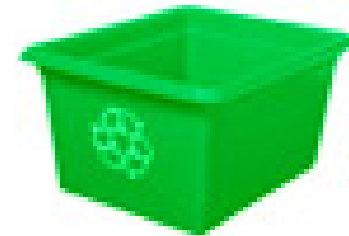
Note: See list of acceptable recyclable items posted above all recycling containers.

Paper Recycling

- Green bins for **paper** recycling will be located in the following areas:
 - All offices
 - All classrooms
 - Guest care/retail
 - Copiers rooms
 - Clock-in and clock-out area

What else is new?

- We will have a few green 95 gallon wheeled recycling cans out by the dumpsters for recyclable items. This is where all recycled items will go for pick up.

- Please take the effort for the earth and be mindful of where you place each piece of garbage. It's an easy way to do your part.

Acceptable items for recycling:

- Plastic bottles #1 and #2, **NO LIDS**
- Glass jars and bottles of any color
- Aluminum, steel and bi-metal can
- Empty aerosol cans **with lids and tips removed**
- Brown grocery bags
- Computer paper and other mixed office paper

More acceptable items for recycling:

- Envelopes, with or without windows
- Junk mail
- Magazines
- Newspapers with inserts
- Paperboard, such as cereal boxes
- Telephone books



AVEDA FREDRIC'S INSTITUTE RECYCLING PROGRAM

How to know what type of plastic can be recycled:

Look on the bottom of the plastic bottle to see what symbol you see below.



AVEDA FREDRIC'S INSTITUTE RECYCLING PROGRAM

Unacceptable items for recycling:

- Plastics #3 - 7
- Plastics #1 and #2 that are NOT bottles, such as Cool Whip containers, butter tubs, or food trays
- Plastic bags
- Motor oil jugs or other chemical containers
- Styrofoam



AVEDA FREDRIC'S INSTITUTE RECYCLING PROGRAM

Unacceptable items for recycling:

- Lids/caps
- Window or drinking glass
- Light bulbs
- Pizza boxes
- Coat hangers or steel scrap
- Paint Cans

Things to remember:

- Please rinse all bottles and jars and remove the lids.
